These materials must be available for public inspection in the main office of each school building until after the budget vote, which is scheduled for Tuesday, May 21, 2019.



Please do not hesitate to refer questions people may express to you about the proposed budget to my office. Also remind them to visit our District website at www.albanyschools.org for additional information.



Under a contingent budget, the tax levy for 2019-20 could not exceed the current 2018-19 tax levy.




ALBANY CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT ENROLLMENT (2017 - 18)


ENROLLMENT BY GENDER




GRADES 3-8 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS SUMMARY RESULTS (2017-18)











ANNUAL REGENTS GEOMETRY (2017-18)







ANNUAL REGENTS LIVING ENVIRONMENT (2017-18)





ANNUAL REGENTS GLOBAL HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY (2017-18)





ANNUAL REGENTS TRANSITION EXAM IN GLOBAL HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY (2017-18)





ANNUAL REGENTS U.S. HISTORY & GOVERNMENT (2017-18)





2014 TOTAL COHORT RESULTS IN REGENTS ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS





2014 TOTAL COHORT RESULTS IN REGENTS MATHEMATICS






